2. Content can be humorous and satirical, but must be in good taste. No videos containing racist, sexist, homophobic, anti-union and/or offensive content will be accepted.
3. Entries will be judged on relevance of message, creativity and impact (*measured by degree of "Wow!" factor*).
4. Entries can be any form or genre: action, comedy, horror, drama, documentary or vlog (i.e. video blog).
5. Submissions by individual members will be accepted, but we strongly encourage collectively produced submissions (e.g. by locals, members from the same workplace or members of PSAC committees).
6. PSAC National Board of Directors and staff may not enter the contest.
7. Entries must be submitted in WMV (*Windows Media Player*) format and e-mailed to communications@psac-afpc.com.
8. Deadline for submissions is December 1, 2008.
